

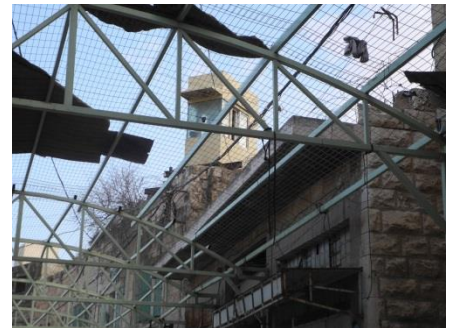
Palestine in My Heart By Theresa Wolfwood
